



Pet Angel World Services, LLC Announces Addition of New Environmentally Friendly Pet Cremation Equipment

New Green, Four-Chamber Incinerator Allows for up to 80% Reduction in Carbon Footprint, Gas Usage

January 29, 2010, Pinellas Park, FL – Pet Angel World Services, LLC, a leading pet cremation and after-care service provider, announced today the addition of a new four-chamber, environmentally friendly cremation incinerator.

Pet Angel World Services conceptualized the incinerator as part of the organization's commitment to being environmentally conscious while staying true to its philosophy of processing only truly private cremations. The unit has four completely separate chambers, each with its own entry door, connected by a common venting system for dispersing the exhaust. Because the chambers are adjacent yet considerably smaller than those in typical units, they take much less gas to heat and also share the heat produced, explained Michael Fuss, President and Chief Executive Officer of Pet Angel World Services.

"Essentially, one hot chamber will help to heat the attached chambers," said Fuss. "This allows us to process truly private cremations – without the risk of cross-contamination – at a carbon footprint and gas usage that is up to 80% less than what is typical of a larger cremation unit."

According to Fuss, most cremation units have only one large chamber. This means truly private cremations only need a small portion of the chamber, thereby using considerably more fuel to complete. In other instances, the operator may add multiple pets into the single chamber at the same time separated in some manner (usually with pans, bricks, or even just space). In the pet cremation industry, this second method is referred to as "separate," "individual," "partitioned," or even erroneously as "private" cremation.

"When more than one pet is in the chamber, it usually means there will be some level of cross-contamination with the other pets," explained Fuss. "Also, it takes more effort to assure the right paperwork goes with the right cremains, with a greater potential for mistakes. Lastly, because the process to empty the chamber is more complex, the unit-more needs to be completely cooled down between loads. This wastes energy as the unit is heated up, cooled down, and then heated back up again for its next use."

Consistent with its philosophy of dignity and respect for pets and compassion for families, Pet Angel World Services is committed to only truly private cremations (with each pet alone in their own chamber), in which the company has complete control over the process and can ensure that each family receives only the cremains of their beloved pet, explained Fuss.

"This unit allows us greater efficiency, which ultimately translates to a healthier environment," he said. "It's all part of our mission to be the green leader in best-in-class pet cremation and after-care services."
